HARTFORD COMMUNITY CHORUS REGISTRATION INFORMATION

OUR MISSION: *As a non-auditioned chorus located in the Kettle Moraine area, we seek to provide singing opportunities to a diverse group of local singers who have come to us with earlier choral experience. We aspire to increase our knowledge and understanding of the art of choral singing. We strive to capture and share “the gift of song” with the listening community through performances of diverse sacred and secular choral literature.*

Now in our 51st year, the Hartford Community Chorus is a non-auditioned group open to all adults who have previous choral experience and love to sing. Under the direction of founder Ruth A. Knoll, the Hartford Community Chorus is an excellent way to meet others who enjoy sharing music. Throughout the concert seasons, the chorus rehearses weekly on Tuesday evenings from 7:30 pm to 9:30 pm at the Schauer Arts & Activities Center. Each season concludes with two concerts. Several Monday evening rehearsals are offered for those desiring additional help and support with the music. The two pre-concert dress rehearsals also involve a Monday-Tuesday sequence in the two weeks prior to performance.

Participation fees for the 2012 Spring concert season is \$20.00– payable to the City of Hartford upon registration. The Community Chorus is under the financial sponsorship of the Hartford Recreation Department, and is a resident tenant of the Schauer Arts & Activities Center which offers additional support with rehearsal and storage space. Except in unusual situations, the concerts are free to the public. Free-will donations at concerts and other community contributions are encouraged and aid in our support.

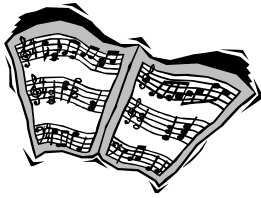
Spring 2012 Concert dates & locations:
